
FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY

This diagram illustrates proper positioning of the upper teeth in the tooth trough during fitting.



- 1. Bring a pan of water to a full boil. Have a bowl of cold water nearby.
- 2. Using a slotted spoon or tongs, completely immerse the mouthpiece into the boiling water for 30 seconds.
- 3. Remove mouthpiece and dip in cold water for 1 second **no more**. Quickly and carefully insert the mouthpiece into the mouth. Make sure front and back teeth are in the tooth trough. **WORK FAST**
- 4. Mold mouthpiece around upper teeth with fingers. Use thumbs to push onto back teeth.
- 5. Close back teeth lightly on mouthpiece to form lower teeth impression. **Be careful not to bite all the way through material.**
- 6. Insert mouthpiece back in boiling water for 2 seconds **no more**. Shake and carefully insert back on teeth where indentations are already make.
- 7. Close teeth together. Quickly use fingers to mold under lips and cheeks.
- 8. Place under cold tap water to set mouthpiece.
- 9. Using a razor blade or sharp scissors, carefully trim excess material.
